EVIDENCE-BASED SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Transitions' supported employment services are evidence-based, research driven services that utilize an Individual Placement and Support (IPS) model. The IPS model emphasizes consumer preferences, rapid job search, support that is not time limited, and the goal of community employment. Employment specialists and job coaches assist consumers in obtaining a job, learning the job responsibilities, and becoming a part of an employee team.

EMPLOYMENT TRAINING SERVICES

Transitions provides in-house vocational training services to those who prefer in-house vocational training opportunities. By completing "real work tasks" outsourced by area businesses, consumers have the opportunity to do meaningful work and earn a paycheck as they learn work skills, work habits, and develop skills that can lead to community employment. In-house work opportunities include packaging and assembly work, laundry work, janitorial work, and secure document destruction. When consumers indicate a desire for community employment, placement staff are ready to help them move forward with their employment goals.
